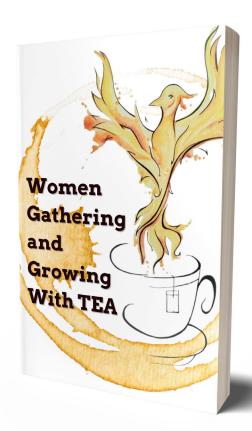
Women Gathering and Growing with TEA
